

More than half the UK's wetland plant species and a quarter of all the UK's larger freshwater invertebrates can be found in the New Forest's ponds.

More than 50% of the ponds mapped within the New Forest National Park qualify as a priority pond – a pond of national importance.

Over a third of all the UK's rarest pond plants and animals can be found in the New Forest.

In the UK, we have identified around 200 Flagship Ponds – sites supporting one or more ponds of exceptional quality; over 40 of these Flagship Pond sites are located within the New Forest.
